    - i. Electronic pump controls installed on wells and reservoir to monitor and record water level.

  - a. Cost of water share is \$9,200.00 and monthly maintenance fee \$30.00.

- i. Recommend no change to monthly rate \$30.00/month.
  - 1. Change billing to 2 rather than 3 tiers.
    - a. Proposed pricing
      - i. Up to 700cf \$30.00
      - ii. 701cf and above additional \$0.022
      - iii. Voted and approved Starting 1 Jan 2024.
- ii. Recommend raising water share cost to \$9,500.00
  - 1. Voted and approved Starting 1 Jan 2024
- b. Monthly meter read:
  - i. Recommend reading + billing 6 times per year versus 12.
  - ii. Voted and approved
    - 1. 2024 readings will occur Jan, Mar, May, July, Sept, Nov
    - 2. Billing will occur when meters are read.
- c. New projects presented to group:
  - i. Filtration System installed at well.
  - ii. Redo line from the Museum south along Custer School RD down Portal Way just past the concrete fence business. This line has had 5 leaks in the last 4 years. Up line to 6" and install hydrant.
  - iii. Redo line on Main St, Bruce Rd west to dead end, increasing to 8" and adding hydrant (s)
  - iv. Interconnect with Old Settlers 6" line on south side of Grandview 1,900ft.
  - v. Phase 2 completion Run line north along Portal Way between golf course and Creasey Rd (project already drawn up).
  - vi. Bore under train tracks at Main St to tie into downtown Custer This would bring connections crossing the tracks to 3.
  - vii.Re-run line on Fox Rd. Currently 2 1/2" small and odd size. Eventually run a line across Vista and down Fox and put a hydrant on corner of Vista and Fox.
  - viii.Expand line at corner of Bruce turning to Arnie to 8" to Valley View.
- d. Open Discussion + New Business
  - i. Addition to project list.
    - 1. Repair line on Valley View, between Arnie and Portal Way. Line is prone to leaks
  - ii. Question concerning amount of water supplied to blueberry growers.
    - 1. By-Laws do not stipulate how water is used.
